

during the year eighteen hundred and ninety-four, may be expended by the quartermaster general during the present year, under the direction of the governor and council, for the construction and repair of buildings or other structures.

SURGEON GENERAL'S DEPARTMENT.

Medical supplies, etc.

For medical supplies for the use of the volunteer militia, and for incidental and contingent expenses of the surgeon general, a sum not exceeding fifteen hundred dollars.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

*Chap. 27* AN ACT TO PREVENT PERSONS FROM UNLAWFULLY WEARING THE INSIGNIA OF THE UNION VETERANS' UNION.

*Be it enacted, etc., as follows :*

Union Veterans' Union, insignia.

Any person not a member of the Union Veterans' Union, who shall wilfully use or wear the insignia of said order for the purpose of representing that he is a member thereof, shall be punished by fine not exceeding twenty dollars or by imprisonment in the house of correction not exceeding thirty days, or by both such fine and imprisonment.

*Chap. 28* AN ACT RELATIVE TO RETURNS TO BE MADE BY THE MASSACHUSETTS HOSPITAL LIFE INSURANCE COMPANY.

*Be it enacted, etc., as follows :*

Exempted from making certain returns.

SECTION 1. The Massachusetts Hospital Life Insurance Company is hereby exempted from making returns to the insurance commissioner during such time as it refrains from issuing policies of life insurance in this Commonwealth.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

*Chap. 29* AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE TOWN OF BEVERLY TO ISSUE BONDS FOR THE PURPOSE OF FUNDING ITS WATER LOAN.

*Be it enacted, etc., as follows :*

Beverly water loan.

SECTION 1. The town of Beverly is hereby authorized to issue, from time to time, bonds to an amount not exceeding in the aggregate one hundred and fifty thousand dollars, for the purpose of funding the notes of the town
