

by any person of obstructions to travel placed by him on the street, remove the same and cause the same to be stored for the benefit of the owners thereof, and whoever accepts or receives the same on storage from such officer shall have a lien thereon for reasonable storage fees and for reasonable expenses of removing the same to the said place of storage : *provided, however*, that if the owner or owners of said personal property so removed and placed upon the street are present and make claim thereto, the officer shall not in that case remove or store the goods, and his action in placing the goods upon the sidewalk or street shall be deemed and held to be the act of the owner or owners of said personal property, who alone shall be held to answer therefor.

Proviso.

Lien not to be enforced by sale of goods within six months.

SECTION 2. The lien hereby given for storage and carting of personal property removed from lands or tenements by officers serving writs of execution for possession of such premises shall not be enforced by sale of the goods stored until the goods have been kept in storage at least six months.

Chap.413

AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE EMPLOYMENT OF MINORS.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows :

Minors not to be employed in handling intoxicating liquors, etc.

SECTION 1. No minor under eighteen years of age shall be employed in handling intoxicating liquors, or in handling packages containing intoxicating liquors, in any brewery or bottling establishment where intoxicating liquors are prepared for sale or offered for sale.

Penalty.

SECTION 2. Whoever violates the provisions of this act shall be punished by a fine of not less than fifty dollars or by imprisonment for not less than three months, or by both such fine and imprisonment for each offence.

Not to prohibit employment of minors in drug stores.

SECTION 3. Nothing in this act shall prohibit the employment of minors in drug stores.

To take effect September 1, 1899.

SECTION 4. This act shall take effect on the first day of September in the year eighteen hundred and ninety-nine.

AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR REPAIRING CERTAIN HIGHWAYS AND BRIDGES IN THE TOWN OF SCITUATE.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows :

Certain highways and bridges in Scituate to be repaired, etc.

SECTION 1. The county commissioners of the county of Plymouth are hereby authorized and empowered to repair, rebuild or relocate and construct such of the high-
