Said scrip or certificates of indebtedness or bonds shall be issued and said sinking fund assessed and collected in accordance with the provisions of said chapter two hundred and eighty-eight of the acts of the year eighteen hundred and ninety-four and of chapter five hundred and fifty of the acts of the year eighteen hundred and ninety-six.

SECTION 3. All work authorized by this act shall be done in accordance with the provisions of section two of chapter four hundred and eighty-one of the acts of the year eighteen hundred and ninety-six.

Work to be done in accordance with 1896, 481, § 2.

SECTION 4. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE SALEM SEAMAN'S ORPHAN AND CHILDREN'S FRIEND SOCIETY TO BECOME THE GUARDIAN OF MINORS.

*Chap. 429*

*Be it enacted, etc., as follows:*

SECTION 1. The Salem Seaman's Orphan and Children's Friend Society may be appointed guardian of minor children, and be authorized to have the control and custody of its wards, in the same manner that individuals may be appointed; and the judge of the probate court having jurisdiction may, in his discretion, exempt said society from furnishing sureties on its bonds as such guardians.

May be appointed guardian of minors.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE TOWN OF ROYALSTON TO APPROPRIATE MONEY FOR BUILDING A TELEPHONE LINE FROM ROYALSTON TO PHILLIPSTON.

*Chap. 430*

*Be it enacted, etc., as follows:*

SECTION 1. The town of Royalston may, by majority vote of the legal voters thereof at a meeting called for the purpose, appropriate not exceeding seven hundred and fifty dollars to meet the expense of building a telephone line from Royalston to Phillipston.

Town of Royalston may appropriate money for building a telephone line.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
