

of January, April, July and October, on the third Friday of February, May and November, and on the second Friday of September; and at New Bedford, on the first Friday of February, May, August and November, and on the third Friday of March, June and September.

SECTION 2. So much of section forty-eight of chapter one hundred and fifty-six of the Public Statutes as relates to holding probate courts in the county of Bristol is hereby repealed. Repeal.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR ALLOWING COSTS TO PARTIES RECOVERING DAMAGES IN GRADE CROSSING CASES.

*Chap.200*

*Be it enacted, etc., as follows:*

SECTION 1. In all proceedings for the recovery of damages sustained in the abolition of grade crossings, and the separating of the grades of highways and railroads, parties recovering damages shall also recover costs as in other civil cases, and the court before which the trial is had may, as a part of such costs, in its discretion make allowances for reasonable expenses incurred for surveys and plans.

Recovery of costs in grade crossing cases.

SECTION 2. This act shall apply to all proceedings pending at the time of its passage.

To apply to certain proceedings.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

AN ACT TO DETERMINE THE TIMES AND PLACES OF HOLDING PROBATE COURTS FOR THE COUNTY OF NORFOLK.

*Chap.201*

*Be it enacted, etc., as follows:*

SECTION 1. Probate courts shall be held in each year for the county of Norfolk, at Dedham, on the first and third Wednesdays, at Quincy, on the second Wednesday, and at Brookline, on the fourth Wednesday of every month except August.

Times and places of holding probate courts for Norfolk county.

SECTION 2. So much of section forty-eight of chapter one hundred and fifty-six of the Public Statutes as relates to holding probate courts for the county of Norfolk is hereby repealed. Repeal.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect on the first day of August in the year eighteen hundred and ninety-eight.

To take effect August 1, 1898.
