WESTERLY by Lots 2A and 3A, as shown on said Plan FOUR HUNDRED FORTY-ONE and 81/100 (441.81') feet;

NORTHWESTERLY by Lot 2C as shown on said Plan, SIXTY-EIGHT and 28/100 (68.28') feet;

NORTHEASTERLY by land now or formerly of Richard E. Cail, as shown on said Plan, FIFTY-FOUR and 31/100 (54.31') feet, as shown on said Plan;

NORTHWESTERLY by land also now or formerly of Richard E. Cail, as shown on said Plan, THIRTY-TWO and 62/100 (32.62') feet;

EASTERLY by Lot 4B, as shown on said Plan FOUR HUNDRED THIRTY-TWO and 78/100 (432.78') feet.

Said Lots 2B and 3B containing, in the aggregate, one acre and 32,793 square feet of land, more or less, according to said Plan.

Chapter 289. AN ACT REGULATING THE DISCLOSURE OF CERTAIN INFORMATION BY THE ATTORNEY GENERAL.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 6 of chapter 93A of the General Laws, as appearing in the 1986 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out, in lines 44 and 45, the words ", or which contains trade secret information".

SECTION 2. Said section 6 of said chapter 93A, as so appearing, is hereby further amended by inserting after the word "same", in line 51, the words: - ; provided, however, that such material or information may be disclosed by the attorney general in court pleadings or other papers filed in court.

SECTION 3. Said section 6 of said chapter 93A, as so appearing, is hereby further amended by inserting after the word "demand", in line 55, the words: - or grant a protective order in accordance with the standards set forth in Rule 26(c) of the Massachusetts Rules of Civil Procedure.
