
ACTS, 1988. – Chaps. 174, 175, 176.

Notwithstanding the provisions of section four A of chapter forty of the General Laws, an agreement entered into by any town or district, located in the county of Franklin for joint fire and police dispatching service, may be terminated by any party thereto only after notice of such termination is given to each other party to the agreement at least one year prior to the date of termination approved by district or town meeting.

Chapter 174. AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE ANNUAL OBSERVANCE OF MASSACHUSETTS ALZHEIMER'S AWARENESS WEEK.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

Chapter 6 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting after section 15FFF, inserted by chapter 606 of the acts of 1987, the following section:-

Section 15GGG. The governor shall annually issue a proclamation setting apart the week following the Sunday following the first Monday of September as Alzheimer's Awareness Week and recommending that said week be observed in an appropriate manner by the people.

Chapter 175. AN ACT RELATIVE TO LENGTH OF MOTOR TRUCKS.
