Chapter 137. AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING THE RIGHTS OF STUDENTS TO FREE EXPRESSION IN CITIES AND TOWNS.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

Chapter 71 of the General Laws is hereby amended by striking out section 86, as appearing in the 1986 Official Edition, and inserting in place thereof the following section:-

Section 86. The provisions of sections eighty-three to eighty-five, inclusive, shall apply only to cities and towns which accept the same.

Chapter 138. AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE OFFICE OF TREASURER-COLLECTOR OF TAXES IN THE TOWN OF HUBBARDSTON.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 1 of chapter 444 of the acts of 1987 is hereby amended by inserting after the word "established", in line 6, the words:- ; provided, however, that the board of selectmen may, at any time it deems it prudent, appoint separate individuals to hold the separate positions of treasurer and collector, each of whom shall be appointed as aforesaid.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect as of the date of the annual town election for the town of Hubbardston in the year nineteen hundred and eighty-eight.

Chapter 139. AN ACT RELATIVE TO CERTAIN FINANCIAL CONDITIONS IN THE CITY OF HOLYOKE.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of any general or special law to the contrary, the city of Holyoke is hereby authorized to borrow at one time or from time to time, a sum in the aggregate not exceeding four million dollars from the commonwealth for the purpose of maintaining and operating the city while it adjusts the level of its operating expenses and operating revenues so as to achieve fiscal stability. No interest shall be payable by the city on account of such loan.

Such loan shall be repaid to the commonwealth in ten equal installments commencing with the fiscal year nineteen hundred and
