which is the same as or necessarily includes, the elements of said offense, shall be punished by a term of imprisonment in the state prison for not less than five nor more than fifteen years and a fine of not less than two thousand five hundred nor more than twenty-five thousand dollars may be imposed but not in lieu of the mandatory minimum term of imprisonment, as established herein.

SECTION 3. Section 32F of said chapter 94C, as so appearing, is hereby amended by adding the following subsection:-

(d) Any person who knowingly or intentionally manufactures, distributes, dispenses, or possesses with intent to manufacture, distribute or dispense a controlled substance as defined in clause (4) of paragraph (a) of class B of section thirty-one, to a person under the age of eighteen years shall be punished by a term of imprisonment in the state prison for not less than five nor more than fifteen years. No sentence imposed under the provisions of this section shall be for less than a minimum term of imprisonment of five years, and a fine of not less than one thousand nor more than twenty-five thousand dollars may be imposed but not in lieu of the mandatory minimum term of imprisonment, as established herein.

SECTION 4. Section 32H of said chapter 94C, as so appearing, is hereby amended by striking out, in line 2, the words "paragraphs (b) and (c)" and inserting in place thereof the words:- paragraphs (b), (c) and (d).

Chapter 126. AN ACT RELATIVE TO REAL ESTATE TAX ABATEMENTS.

Section 4 of chapter 73 of the acts of 1986 is hereby amended by striking out, in line 23, the words "board of selectmen" and inserting in place thereof the words:- majority vote at a town meeting.

Chapter 127. AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE GRANBY TELEPHONE AND TELEGRAPH COMPANY OF MASSACHUSETTS TO BORROW AN ADDITIONAL SUM OF MONEY.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

The Granby Telephone and Telegraph Company of Massachusetts is hereby authorized to borrow an additional sum of money, not exceeding five hundred and nineteen thousand seven hundred and fifty dollars, and to execute bonds, notes or other evidences of indebtedness payable to any person, or to order and to deliver such bonds, notes or other

evidences of indebtedness in consideration of such loan, and to mortgage, pledge or hypothecate any or all of its assets as security therefor; provided, however, that all of the provisions of chapter one hundred and sixty-six of the General Laws, except as specifically otherwise provided herein, shall be applicable and shall govern such indebtedness or any part thereof, or bonds, coupon notes or other evidences of indebtedness issued hereunder, including specifically the provisions of sections four, five and six of said chapter one hundred and sixty-six.

Chapter 128. AN ACT RELATIVE TO GUIDELINES FOR THE VOLUNTARY PLACEMENT OF CHILDREN IN FOSTER CARE.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

Subparagraph A of section 23 of chapter 119 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 1986 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the first sentence the following sentence:- Said judgment shall be exercised in accordance with guidelines and standards developed by said department and shall be reviewed by the executive office of human services.

Chapter 129. AN ACT AUTHORIZING ENERGY CONSERVATION FUNDING BY THE MASSACHUSETTS MUNICIPAL WHOLESALE ELECTRIC COMPANY.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 1 of chapter 775 of the acts of 1975 is hereby amended by inserting before the definition of "Bonds" or "bond" the following definition:-

"Alternative energy facilities". shall include but not be limited to facilities powered in whole or in part by the sun, wind, water, biomass, refuse, alcohol, wood or any renewable non-depletable fuel, and cogeneration.

SECTION 2. Said section 1 of said chapter 775 is hereby further amended by striking out the definition of "Electric power facilities", or "electric power facility" and inserting in place thereof the following two definitions:-

"Electric power facilities" or "electric power facility", any system or facility including any energy conservation system or alternative energy facility, for the generation, transmission, transformation or conservation of electric power and energy by any means whatsoever, including,
