"Governmental body", every board, commission, committee or subcommittee of any district, city, region or town, however elected, appointed or otherwise constituted, and the governing board of a local housing, redevelopment or similar authority; provided, however, that this definition shall not include a town meeting.

SECTION 4. The seventh paragraph of section 23B of said chapter 39, as so appearing, is hereby further amended by adding the following sentence:- No votes taken in open session shall be by secret ballot.

Chapter 117. AN ACT DESIGNATING A SUITABLE MARKER FOR WOODROW BESWICK.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

The metropolitan district commission shall designate a certain park bench in William Fitzgerald Park, in the Dorchester district of the city of Boston as the Woodrow Beswick bench in memory of Woodrow Beswick. A suitable marker bearing such designation shall be affixed thereon by said metropolitan district commission.

Chapter 118. AN ACT CLARIFYING THE JURISDICTION OF A MUNICIPAL INSPECTOR OF WIRES.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

Section 32 of chapter 166 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 1986 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out, in lines 9 and 10, the words "a building designed to carry an electric light, heat, or power current" and inserting in place thereof the following words:- or supplied from buildings and structures subject to the provisions of chapter one hundred and forty-three, and the state building code.

Chapter 119. AN ACT DIRECTING THE COUNTY OF HAMPDEN TO CONVEY CERTAIN PARK LAND TO THE CITY KNOWN AS THE TOWN OF AGAWAM.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:
