Chapter 107. AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING THE WORK EXPERIENCE REQUIREMENT FOR CERTAIN GOVERNMENT AUDITORS.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

Section 87A 1/2 of chapter 112 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 1986 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out, in line 78, the word "practice." and inserting in place thereof the following:—practice, or

(iii) field audit work, including the direct supervision of field audit work, with the United States Government or any agency or subdivision of the commonwealth with a demonstrated emphasis on the expression of opinions on financial statements in accordance with generally accepted auditing standards, the review of and report on internal controls, the application of varied auditing procedures, the preparation of audit working papers for account examinations, the planning of auditing work programs, the preparation of written explanations and comments on examination findings and the preparation and analysis of financial statements. The experience required by this clause, as approved by the board, shall be considered work experience on the same basis as experience in public accounting practices; provided, however, that adherence to the standard of independence is strictly applied.

Chapter 108. AN ACT EXEMPTING THE POSITION OF INSPECTOR OF BUILDINGS OF THE TOWN OF WATERTOWN FROM THE CIVIL SERVICE LAW.

SECTION 1. Chapter two of the acts of nineteen hundred and twenty-six is hereby repealed.

SECTION 1A. Notwithstanding any provision of general or special law to the contrary, the provisions of chapter thirty-one of the General Laws, and the rules and regulations made thereunder, shall hereafter not apply to the inspector of buildings of the city known as the town of Watertown.

SECTION 1B. The city known as the town of Watertown is hereby authorized to enact general and zoning ordinances consistent with the terms of this act and with the General Laws to provide for the employment and duties of the inspector of buildings.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
