

**Chap.236** AN ACT TO CHANGE THE NAME OF THE EPISCOPAL METHODIST SOCIETY OF COCHITUATE, TO CONFIRM CERTAIN PROCEEDINGS OF SAID SOCIETY AND CERTAIN CONVEYANCES TO THE SAME, AND TO AUTHORIZE SAID SOCIETY TO SELL ITS REAL AND PERSONAL ESTATE.

*Be it enacted, etc., as follows:*

Name changed. SECTION 1. The name of the Episcopal Methodist Society of Cochituate, a religious corporation in the town of Wayland, organized under the general laws of this Commonwealth on the twenty-third day of April in the year eighteen hundred and sixty-six, is hereby changed to the "Methodist Episcopal Society of Cochituate."

Acts confirmed. SECTION 2. All acts done prior to the passage of this act under the name of the Methodist Episcopal Society of Cochituate shall have the same force and effect as if done under the name of the Episcopal Methodist Society of Cochituate.

Conveyances made valid. SECTION 3. All conveyances by deed or otherwise made to the Episcopal Methodist Society of Cochituate under the name of the Methodist Episcopal Society of Cochituate are ratified, confirmed and made valid to the same extent as if made under the name of the Episcopal Methodist Society of Cochituate.

May sell real and personal estate. SECTION 4. The Methodist Episcopal Society of Cochituate is authorized to sell and convey by deed and bill of sale all its real and personal estate unto the trustees of the Methodist Episcopal Church of Cochituate.

SECTION 5. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

**Chap.237** AN ACT RELATING TO THE EAST BOSTON RAILWAY DOCK AND ELEVATOR COMPANY.

*Be it enacted, etc., as follows:*

Time extended for completion of organization. SECTION 1. The East Boston Railway Dock and Elevator Company, incorporated by chapter two hundred and eighty-eight of the acts of eighteen hundred and eighty-one, may at any time within two years from the thirteenth day of May eighteen hundred and eighty-three complete its organization, and may at any time within said period take land and do such other things as are authorized by said chapter to be done within two years from the passage of said act of incorporation.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
