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ACTS, 1988. - Chap. 12.

Twelfth Worcester. - Consisting of the town of Clinton, precinct two, of the town of Lancaster, and the towns of Princeton, Sterling, West Boylston and Westminster, all in the county of Worcester.

Thirteenth Worcester. - Consisting of the town of Paxton, and all precincts of wards one and nine; of the city of Worcester, all in the county of Worcester.

Fourteenth Worcester. - Consisting of all precincts of wards two and three, and precinct four of ward ten, of the city of Worcester, in the county of Worcester.

Fifteenth Worcester. - Consisting of all precincts of ward four, precinct five of ward five, precinct three of ward eight, and precincts one, two, three, five, six and seven of ward ten, of the city of Worcester, in the county of Worcester.

Sixteenth Worcester. - Consisting of precincts one, two, three, four, six and seven of ward five, all precincts of ward six, and precincts one and four of ward eight, of the city of Worcester, in the county of Worcester.

Seventeenth Worcester. - Consisting of the town of Leicester, all precincts of ward seven and precincts two, five, six, seven and eight of ward eight, of the city of Worcester, all in the county of Worcester.

**SECTION 5.** The supreme judicial court shall have jurisdiction of any petition for a writ of mandamus relative to the establishment of one hundred and sixty representative districts under section three of this act. Every such petition shall be filed in said court within ten days after the effective date of this act.

**SECTION 6.** Notwithstanding the provisions of section forty-seven of chapter fifty-three of the General Laws, the state secretary shall furnish nomination papers for use in the nomination of candidates to be voted for at the nineteen hundred and eighty-eight state primary, or in the case of unenrolled candidates to be voted for at the nineteen hundred and eighty-eight state election, for the office of state representative upon the effective date of this act.

**SECTION 7.** This act shall take effect upon its passage.

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Chapter 12.     **AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE STATE TREASURER TO  
ISSUE CERTAIN BONDS OF THE COMMONWEALTH  
PREVIOUSLY AUTHORIZED.**

Whereas, The deferred operation of this act would tend to defeat its purpose, which is to immediately facilitate the issuance of certain bonds of the commonwealth previously authorized and in anticipation of the issuance of which, moneys have been advanced from the state treasury, therefore it is hereby declared to be an emergency law, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public convenience.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

**SECTION 1.** The first paragraph of section 3 of chapter 747 of the acts of 1970 is hereby amended by striking out, in lines 8 and 9, the words "but not later than June the thirtieth, nineteen hundred and eighty-five".

**SECTION 2.** The second paragraph of said section 3 of said chapter 747 is hereby amended by striking out the last sentence and inserting in place thereof the following sentence:- The initial maturities of such bonds shall be payable not later than one year from the date of issue thereof, and the entire issue not later than June the thirtieth, two thousand and fifteen.

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**Chapter 13. AN ACT DESIGNATING A CERTAIN BRIDGE IN THE TOWN OF UXBRIDGE AS THE CAPTAIN JAMES BUXTON MEMORIAL BRIDGE.**

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

The bridge, located on Buxton street in the town of Uxbridge over state highway Route 146, shall be designated and known as the Captain James Buxton Memorial Bridge, in memory of Captain James Buxton, a native of the town of Uxbridge who was a leading figure in the American Revolutionary War. Suitable markers bearing such designation shall be attached thereto by the department of public works in compliance with the standards of said department.

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**Chapter 14. AN ACT EXEMPTING THE CITY OF WORCESTER FROM CERTAIN BIDDING PROCEDURES IN PROCURING MODULAR BUILDINGS FOR CLASSROOMS.**

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

**SECTION 1.** The city of Worcester is hereby authorized to procure, in accordance with the provisions of this act, not more than twenty-three modular buildings for use as classrooms.

As used in this act, the term "modular buildings" shall mean a pre-designed building or units of a pre-designed building constructed and equipped with internal plumbing, electrical or similar systems prior to movement to the site where such units are attached to each other and such building is affixed to a foundation and connected to external utilities; or any portable structure with walls, a floor and a roof.
