

Chapter 149. AN ACT EXEMPTING THE POSITION OF PRINCIPAL CIVIL ENGINEER IN THE DEPARTMENT OF TRAFFIC ENGINEERING OF THE CITY OF WORCESTER FROM THE PROVISIONS OF THE CIVIL SERVICE LAW.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

SECTION 1. The position of principal civil engineer in the department of traffic engineering of the city of Worcester shall be exempt from the provisions of chapter thirty-one of the General Laws.

SECTION 2. The provisions of section one of this act shall not impair the civil service status of the incumbent of said position of principal civil engineer in the department of traffic engineering of the city of Worcester on the effective date of this act.

Chapter 150. AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE TOWN OF WEYMOUTH TO INDEMNIFY GEORGE D. LEBRUN, A RETIRED POLICE OFFICER IN SAID TOWN.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

SECTION 1. The town of Weymouth is hereby authorized to indemnify George D. Lebrun, a retired police officer receiving a disability pension from said town, for prosthetic and related expenses incurred in October, nineteen hundred and eighty-seven; provided, however, that said indemnification shall not exceed twelve hundred dollars.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

Chapter 151. AN ACT REGULATING PETS IN CERTAIN PUBLIC HOUSING.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 3 of chapter 23B of the General Laws, as appearing in the 1986 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out, in line 125, the word "fifty-one B." and inserting in place thereof the following:- fifty-one B;

(u) establish, conduct and maintain a program of pet ownership by elderly residents of state-aided public housing for the elderly.

SECTION 2. (A) The department of community affairs is hereby authorized and directed to establish a program to grant waivers to elderly residents of state-aided public housing for the elderly to allow ownership of pets in such public housing. Applications for such waiver shall be attached to each lease for such housing. In order to qualify for a waiver such elderly resident shall comply with all the terms and conditions set forth herein and established by the department in its rules and regulations and upon such compliance a waiver shall be granted.
