

**SECTION 5.** Section five of chapter five hundred and fifty-five of the acts of nineteen hundred and seventy-eight is hereby repealed.

**SECTION 6.** This act shall take effect upon its passage.

**Chapter 199. AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE STATE SECRETARY TO AUTHORIZE THE SOLEMNIZATION OF A CERTAIN MARRIAGE.**

*Whereas*, The deferred operation of this act would tend to defeat its purpose, which is to immediately authorize the solemnization of a certain marriage, therefore it is hereby declared to be an emergency law, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public convenience.

*Be it enacted, etc., as follows:*

Notwithstanding the provisions of section thirty-nine of chapter two hundred and seven of the General Laws, the state secretary may authorize in the manner set forth under said section thirty-nine, the solemnization of a marriage by Jon David Jacobs, as he is an attorney-at-law in the state of New York, in the town of Brewster on August twentieth, nineteen hundred and eighty-nine between Cheryl L. Jacobs of the city of Boston and Alex S. Ehrlich of the city of New York in the state of New York, and the state secretary shall issue to said Jon David Jacobs in his capacity as aforesaid a certificate of such authorization.

**Chapter 200. AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE BARNSTABLE COUNTY CHARTER.**

*Be it enacted, etc., as follows:*

Section 2 of chapter 163 of the acts of 1988 is hereby amended by striking out, in lines 2 to 4, inclusive, the words "twenty-three of chapter sixty-four D of the General Laws and chapter five hundred and forty-six of the acts of nineteen hundred and sixty-nine" and inserting in place thereof the words:- one of chapter sixty-four D of the General Laws and section twenty-three of chapter five hundred and forty-six of the acts of nineteen hundred and sixty-nine.

**Chapter 201. AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING THE REQUIREMENTS FOR ELEVATOR MECHANICS LICENSES.**

*Be it enacted, etc., as follows:*

Section 71B of chapter 143 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 1986 Official Edition is hereby amended by striking out the third sentence.
