

**Chapter 405. AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING EMERGENCY VEHICLES.**

*Be it enacted, etc., as follows:*

Chapter 111C of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting after section 10 the following section:-

Section 10A. An injured or sick child who is to be transported to a hospital or other medical treatment facility by an ambulance or other emergency vehicle shall be accompanied by a parent upon such parent's request, unless the emergency medical technician or other person in charge determines that the medical situation is life threatening or that the presence of a parent would create a potential risk to such child. Such determination shall be noted in the written report of said emergency medical technician and a copy of such report shall be sent to such parent within thirty days of such determination.

**Chapter 406. AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING THE USE OF THE WATERS OF LAKE QUINSIGAMOND.**

*Be it enacted, etc., as follows:*

**SECTION 1.** Chapter 294 of the Special Acts of 1916 is hereby amended by inserting after section 6 the following section:-

*Section 6A.* No person shall place any mooring, raft, docks or wharfs into or upon the waters nor any structure on the ice of said lake without receiving a permit from said commission. Said commission shall adopt suitable rules and regulations for the issuance of said permits.

**SECTION 2.** Said chapter 294 is hereby further amended by striking out section 9 and inserting in place thereof the following section:-

*Section 9.* Any person who violates any rule, regulation or order of said commission or any provision hereof shall be punished by a fine of not less than fifty nor more than five hundred dollars for each offense.

**SECTION 3.** This act shall take effect upon its passage.
