

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of any general or special law to the contrary, all acts and proceedings of the town of Braintree at its annual town meeting held on May first, nineteen hundred and eighty-nine, and all actions taken pursuant thereto are hereby ratified, validated and confirmed to the same extent as if the summary of the warrant for such meeting had been published as required by law.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

Chapter 414. AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE TOWN OF BRAINTREE TO REIMBURSE CERTAIN EXCISE TAXES.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of any general or special law to the contrary, the town of Braintree is hereby authorized to appropriate for the payment of and after such appropriation the treasurer of said town is authorized to pay to Thomas J. Moakley the sum of two hundred and thirty-five dollars, such sum being reimbursement for motor vehicle excise taxes paid in error for a motor vehicle excise tax for the year nineteen hundred and eighty-seven.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

Chapter 415. AN ACT PROHIBITING GOOD CONDUCT DEDUCTIONS UNTIL THE MANDATORY MINIMUM SENTENCES FOR CERTAIN DRUG OFFENSES IS SERVED.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

Section 32H of chapter 94C of the General Laws, as appearing in the 1988 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out, in line 14, the words "or work release" and inserting in place thereof the words: - work release, or receive any deduction from his sentence for good conduct under sections one hundred and twenty-nine, one hundred and twenty-nine A, one hundred and twenty-nine C and one hundred and twenty-nine D of chapter one hundred and twenty-seven.
