Chapter 563. AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE TAKING OF THE OATH OF OFFICE OF CERTAIN CITY OFFICIALS OF THE CITY OF NEW BEDFORD.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

Notwithstanding the provisions of section seventeen of chapter forty-three of the General Laws or any other general or special law to the contrary, the mayor-elect if elected by the people, the councillors-elect and the assessors-elect if elected by the people of the city of New Bedford, shall meet and be sworn to the faithful discharge of their duties on the first Monday in January following a regular election at seven o'clock post meridiem.

Chapter 564. AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE INSTALLATION OF A CERTAIN PLAQUE ON THE EXTERIOR OF THE STATE HOUSE GARAGE, SO-CALLED.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

The George B. Henderson Foundation is hereby authorized to install a plaque commemorating the origin of the name "Derne Street" on the Derne street wall of the garage to be constructed on the east side of the state house annex.

The Massachusetts art commission and the Massachusetts historical commission, jointly, shall act in an advisory capacity with regard to the design and location of said plaque.
