

Chap. 61. AN ACT TO INCORPORATE THE MOUNT ADNAH CEMETERY COMPANY.
Be it enacted, &c., as follows :

<p>Corporators.</p> <p>Title.</p> <p>Purpose.</p> <p>Location.</p> <p>Powers, duties, &c.</p> <p>Real and personal estate.</p>	<p>SECTION 1. Nathaniel Duley, George Norwood, Thomas Chard, William Bragdon, their associates and successors, are hereby made a corporation, by the name of the Mount Adnah Cemetery Company; for the purpose of establishing and perpetuating a place for the burial of the dead, to be located in the town of Gloucester, in the county of Essex: and shall have all the powers and privileges, and be subject to all the duties, liabilities and restrictions, set forth in the sixtieth and sixty-eighth chapters of the General Statutes.</p> <p>SECTION 2. Said corporation may hold real and personal estate necessary and convenient for the purposes aforesaid, not exceeding in amount the sum of five thousand dollars.</p> <p>SECTION 3. 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Chap. 62. AN ACT DEFINING THE TIMES OF HOLDING THE CRIMINAL TERMS OF THE SUPERIOR COURT FOR THE COUNTY OF ESSEX.

Be it enacted, &c., as follows :

<p>Newburyport, Lawrence and Salem.</p> <p>Returns, when to be made.</p>	<p>SECTION 1. The terms of the superior court, for the transaction of criminal business in the county of Essex, shall be holden at Newburyport, on the second Monday of May; at Lawrence, on the second Monday of October; and at Salem, on the fourth Monday of January, annually.</p> <p>SECTION 2. All writs, processes, bonds and recognizances, which shall be made returnable to said court, at Salem, on the fourth Monday of October next, shall be returned to, be entered at, and have day in, the term of said court to be held at Lawrence, on the second Monday of October next.</p> <p>SECTION 3. 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Chap. 63. AN ACT CONCERNING THE DANVERS RAILROAD COMPANY.
Be it enacted, &c., as follows :

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Chap. 64. AN ACT IN ADDITION TO AN ACT RELATING TO ESSEX BRIDGE.
