HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES, January 18, 1859.

The Committee on the Judiciary, who were instructed by an Order of the House to inquire into the expediency of additional legislation concerning the Terms of the Supreme Judicial Court in the counties of Middlesex and Plymouth, report the accompanying Bill.

AN ACT

Concerning the Terms of the Supreme Judicial Court in the Counties of Franklin, Middlesex and Plymouth.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1 SECT. 1. The term of the supreme judicial court
2 now appointed by law to be held at Greenfield, in the
3 county of Franklin, on the second Tuesday of Sep-
4 tember, shall be held on the second Tuesday of April,
5 and all writs, processes and recognizances made
6 returnable to the term of said court on the second
7 Tuesday of September, shall be returned to and
8 entered at the term of said court, to be held on the
9 second Tuesday of April.

1 SECT. 2. The term of the supreme judicial court
2 now appointed by law to be held at Lowell on the

3 first Tuesday of May, shall be held on the third
4 Tuesday of April, and all writs, processes and recog-
5 nizances made returnable to the term of said court on
6 the first Tuesday of May, shall be returned to and
7 entered at the term of said court, to be held on the
8 third Tuesday of April.

1 SECT. 3. The term of the supreme judicial court,
2 now by law appointed to be held at Plymouth, on
3 the second Tuesday of July, shall be held on the
4 second Tuesday of May, and all writs, processes and
5 recognizances made returnable to the term of said
6 court on the second Tuesday of July, shall be returned
7 to and entered at the term of said court, to be held
8 on the second Tuesday of May.

1 SECT. 4. This act shall take effect from its passage.
