
By Mr. Bocko of Billerica, petition of Stanley J. Bocko and another for legislation to provide tenure of office for Robert H. Fowler, incumbent of the office of town treasurer of the town of Billerica. Towns.

AN ACT PROVIDING TENURE OF OFFICE UNTIL AGE SEVENTY FOR ROBERT H. FOWLER, INCUMBENT OF THE OFFICE OF TOWN TREASURER OF THE TOWN OF BILLERICA.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Robert H. Fowler, incumbent of the office of
2 town treasurer of the town of Billerica, shall hold said office
3 during good behavior until he reaches age seventy, unless in-
4 capacitated by physical or mental disability from performing
5 the duties thereof, but he may be removed therefrom for cause
6 after hearing in the manner provided by section forty-three of
7 chapter thirty-one of the General Laws.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall be submitted to the voters of said
2 town at the annual town meeting in the current year in the form
3 of the following question, which shall be placed upon the official
4 ballot to be used for the election of town officers at said meet-
5 ing:— “Shall an act passed by the General Court in the year
6 nineteen hundred and sixty-four, entitled ‘An Act providing
7 tenure of office until age seventy for Robert H. Fowler, incum-
8 bent of the office of town treasurer of the town of Billerica’, be
9 accepted?”. If a majority of the votes in answer to said question
10 is in the affirmative, this act shall thereupon take full effect,
11 but not otherwise.
