## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirty.

An Act authorizing the City of Medford to borrow  
Money for School Purposes.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. For the purpose of constructing  
2 school buildings and/or additions or alterations  
3 to existing school buildings and for the acqui-  
4 sition of land by eminent domain or otherwise,  
5 the city of Medford may borrow from time to  
6 time during the years 1930 and 1931 a sum not  
7 to exceed eight hundred and fifty thousand  
8 dollars outside the debt limit.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon  
2 its passage.
