AN ACT

To regulate the Use of Hat Pins.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. It shall be unlawful for any person to
2 wear in public a hat pin unless the point of the hat
3 pin is protected in such manner as to prevent the
4 injury of persons coming in contact therewith.

1 SECTION 2. Violation of the provisions of this
2 act shall be punished by a fine of not more than one
3 hundred dollars for each offence.
