AN ACT ALLOWING THE TOWN OF WINCHESTER TO GRANT CERTAIN PERMITS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of section fifty-
2 four A of chapter forty the town of Winchester is hereby
3 authorized to grant permits to build structures upon the land in
4 the so-called "Woburn Loop" without obtaining the consent to
5 the issuance of such permits from the secretary of the executive
6 office of transportation and construction, provided, however, that
7 the town issue such permits in compliance with all other
8 appropriate by-laws of said town and the General Laws.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
