AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BERKSHIRE COUNTY TO SELL CERTAIN REAL ESTATE IN THE CITY OF PITTSFIELD TO THE CITY OF PITTSFIELD.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The County Commissioners of Berkshire
2 County are hereby authorized to sell approximately 4.3 acres of
3 land owned by the County of Berkshire and now used as part of
4 the Jail and House of Correction property to the City of
5 Pittsfield for such price and upon such terms and conditions as
6 may be determined by said County Commissioners for use by the
7 City of Pittsfield as a site for a community school, said area is
8 more particularly shown upon a plan entitled "City of Pittsfield,
9 Dept. of Public Works, Berk. Cty. Jail Property For East Side
10 Comm. School Site" dated March 27, 1973, as revised by the
11 County Engineers.

1 SECTION 2. The County Commissioners are further
2 authorized to place the money received by the County from the
3 sale of said property in a reserve fund to be used for the purpose
4 of hiring architects and engineers to prepare plans for a new Jail
5 and House of Correction for Berkshire County and for the
6 acquisition of land for such new Jail and House of Correction
7 and for the construction of a new Jail and House of Correction in
8 the County of Berkshire.
