AN ACT RELATIVE TO INCREASING THE AMOUNTS OF PENSIONS,
RETIREMENT ALLOWANCES AND ANNUITIES PAYABLE TO CERTAIN
FORMER PUBLIC EMPLOYEES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 1 of chapter 670 of the acts of 1955 is hereby amended
2 by striking out the words "had attained age sixty and", as
3 they appear in line 9 therein, and inserting therefor the follow-
4 ing: — regardless of age.
