## **The Commonwealth of Massachusetts**

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Ninety.

AN ACT PROVIDING THAT PERSONS OBTAINING DRIVERS LICENSES SHALL BE REQUIRED TO ANSWER QUESTIONS REGARDING ALCOHOL ABUSE.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Section 8 of Chapter 90 of the General Laws is hereby amended
- 2 by adding the following paragraph at the end thereof: —
- 3 “Applicants for a license under this section shall be required to
- 4 answer questions on the examination; the number of which the
- 5 Registrar shall decide, that relate to alcohol or alcohol problems
- 6 under Chapter 138 and Chapter 90 of the General Laws.”
