Chap. 401. AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE BOUNDARIES OF  
THE HYANNIS FIRE DISTRICT.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

The Hyannis Fire District's boundaries are hereby ratified and confirmed as follows:- westerly by the Centerville-Osterville Fire District; northerly by the Barnstable Fire District; easterly by the Barnstable-Yarmouth town line; and southerly by the waters of Nantucket Sound.

Chap. 402. AN ACT DESIGNATING THE POEM "BLUE HILLS  
OF MASSACHUSETTS" AS THE OFFICIAL STATE  
POEM OF THE COMMONWEALTH.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

Chapter 2 of the General Laws is hereby amended by adding after section 20, added by section 2 of chapter 383 of the acts of 1981, the following section:-

Section 21. The poem, "Blue Hills of Massachusetts" composed by Katherine E. Mullen of the town of Barre shall be the official state poem of the commonwealth.

Chap. 403. AN ACT MAKING A CORRECTIVE CHANGE IN  
THE CLAIMS AND INDEMNITY PROCEDURES FOR  
POLITICAL SUBDIVISIONS.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

The definition of "Public employer" in section 1 of chapter 258 of the General Laws, as amended by section 1 of chapter 315 of the acts of 1980, is hereby further amended by adding the following sentence:- With respect to public employees of a school committee of a city or town, the public employer for the purposes of this chapter shall be deemed to be said respective
