

Chap. 288 AN ACT TO INCORPORATE THE SAINT PATRICK'S TEMPERANCE SOCIETY.*Be it enacted, &c., as follows :*

Corporators.

SECTION 1. Michael O'Brien, Andrew J. Teeling and Patrick Moran, their associates and successors, are hereby made a corporation by the name of the Saint Patrick's Temperance Society, for the purpose of promoting the cause of temperance in the city of Lowell, and of benefiting the condition of their members, by assisting them in time of sickness ;

with all the powers and privileges, and subject to all the duties, liabilities and restrictions set forth in all general laws which now are or may hereafter be in force, so far as applicable to said corporation.

Real and personal estate.

SECTION 2. Said corporation may hold for the purposes aforesaid, real and personal estate to the amount of fifteen thousand dollars.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

*Approved May 15, 1869.***Chap. 289** AN ACT TO INCORPORATE THE LYNN ODD FELLOWS' HALL ASSOCIATION.*Be it enacted, &c., as follows :*

Corporators.

SECTION 1. N. M. Hawkes, John Q. Hammond, Benjamin H. Currier, Henry C. Oliver, Harmon Hall, their associates and successors, trustees of the fund of the Odd Fellows' Hall Association in Lynn, are hereby made a corporation under the name of the Lynn Odd Fellows' Hall Association, for the purpose of managing and administering the funds belonging to said association, and of building and maintaining a hall, according to the terms of their trust ; with all the powers and privileges, and subject to all the duties, restrictions and liabilities set forth in all general laws which now are or may hereafter be in force applicable to such corporations.

SECTION 2. Said corporation may hold real and personal estate to an amount not exceeding one hundred thousand dollars.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

*Approved May 15, 1869.***Chap. 290** AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE ELISHA NELSON AND OTHERS TO BUILD A WHARF IN PLYMOUTH.*Be it enacted, &c., as follows :*

May build wharf in Plymouth.

SECTION 1. License is hereby granted to Elisha Nelson, Henry Sherman and Charles Nelson, or any one of them or their assigns, to build a wharf in Plymouth one thousand and fifty feet in length, and not exceeding thirty feet in width, towards the channel known as Goose Point Channel,
