AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR THE ERECTION AND MAINTENANCE
OF A BATH HOUSE AT NEW BEACH, PROVINCETOWN, BY
THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The department of public works is hereby author-
2 ized and directed to construct, maintain and operate
3 a bath house at New beach, at Provincetown, at a
4 cost of not more than twenty-five thousand dollars
5 for the erection thereof.
