AN ACT REQUIRING THE MASSACHUSETTS BAY TRANSPORTATION AUTHORITY TO ESTABLISH A SYSTEM OF ELECTRONIC COMMUNICATION BETWEEN RAPID TRANSIT TRAINS AND ITS POLICE DEPARTMENT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 5 of chapter 161A of the General Laws is hereby
2 amended by adding after subsection (k) the following sub-
3 section: —

4 (l) The Authority shall establish and maintain a system of
5 electronic communication between each vehicle used in rapid
6 transit service and the police department of the Authority, as
7 established by chapter six hundred and sixty-four of the acts of
8 nineteen hundred and sixty-eight.
