## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Fifty-Five.

AN ACT PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY RELATIVE TO THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A MARKET AUTHORITY IN THE CITY OF SPRINGFIELD, AND A SURVEY AND STUDY RELATIVE TO PARKING AREAS IN SAID CITY.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Upon the acceptance of this act as here-  
2 inafter provided, there shall be a committee composed  
3 of three persons to be appointed by the mayor of the  
4 city of Springfield for the purpose of making an inves-  
5 tigation and study relative to the advisability and feasi-  
6 bility of establishing a Springfield market authority.  
7 Said committee shall, in making its investigation and  
8 study, consider the subject matter of current house docu-  
9 ment numbered 1548, establishing the Springfield market  
10 authority and defining its powers and duties. Said com-  
11 mittee shall also make a survey and study of the matter  
12 of on and off street parking areas within said city, with  
13 special reference to the taking of property for such areas,  
14 and the cost, control and maintenance thereof.

15 Said committee shall report the results of its inves-  
16 tigation, survey and study hereunder, and its recom-  
17 mendations, if any, together with drafts of legislation  
18 necessary to carry such recommendation into effect, by  
19 filing the same with the mayor of said city and a copy  
20 thereof with the clerk of the senate on or before De-  
21 cember thirty-first in the current year.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its ac-  
2 ceptance by the city council of the city of Springfield,  
3 subject to the provisions of its charter, but not other-  
4 wise.
