### RESOLVE

Providing for Repairing and Enlarging Crocker Hall, and certain other Repairs at the State Normal School at Framingham.

1 *Resolved*, That there be allowed and paid out of the  
2 treasury of the Commonwealth a sum not exceeding  
3 twenty-eight thousand five hundred dollars, to be ex-  
4 pended at the State Normal School at Framingham un-  
5 der the direction of the State Board of Education, for the  
6 following purposes, to wit:— For repairing and enlarg-  
7 ing the building known as Crocker Hall, a sum not ex-  
8 ceeding twenty-seven thousand dollars; and for changes  
9 in water works and connecting them with the system of  
10 water works in the town of Framingham, a sum not ex-  
11 ceeding fifteen hundred dollars.
