AN ACT RELATIVE TO SMOKE DETECTORS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 148 of the General Laws is hereby amended by
- 2 inserting after Section 26F the following section:—
- 3 Section 26F½. All dormitories, fraternity houses and sorority
- 4 houses shall be equipped with “hard-wired” smoke detectors, so-
- 5 called, in all common hallway areas.
