## **The Commonwealth of Massachusetts**

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Ninety-One.

AN ACT CREATING A PENALTY FOR FAILURE TO PAY THE STATE LOTTERY.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 30A of Chapter 10 inserted by Chapter 63 of the Acts  
2 of 1973 is hereby amended by adding thereto the following  
3 paragraph: —

4 Whoever, being an agent licensed to sell lottery tickets or shares  
5 pursuant to this chapter, who fails or refuses to pay a lottery  
6 commission invoice within two days after receiving notice that  
7 such payment is overdue shall be punished by imprisonment in  
8 a jail or house of correction for not more than one year, or by  
9 a fine of not less than One Hundred Dollars. The word "overdue"  
10 as used herein, shall be construed to mean nonpayment of the  
11 invoice on the seventh day following delivery thereof to the agent.
