The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Eighty-Two.

AN ACT REQUIRING THE TRANSFER TO THE COMMONWEALTH OF THE JAILS AND HOUSES OF CORRECTION NOW OWNED AND OPERATED BY THE SEVERAL COUNTIES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Not later than January first, nineteen hundred and eighty-two,
- 2 the commonwealth shall assume all administrative and other costs
- 3 involved in the operation of county jails and houses of correction
- 4 and other correction facilities and the cost of alterations, remodel-
- 5 ings or new construction of such facilities.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled, That

SEC. 1. Construction of the term "facility"
