AN ACT DESIGNATING THE BRIDGE OVER ROUTE 25 ON PLYMOUTH ROAD EXTENSION IN THE TOWN OF WAREHAM AS THE CORPORAL CARL D. WAKEFIELD, JR. MEMORIAL BRIDGE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The bridge over route 25 on the Plymouth road extension in the
2 town of Wareham, and further identified as state bridge number
3 W-6-37, shall be designated and known as the Carl D. Wakefield,
4 Jr. Memorial Bridge, in memory of Corporal Carl D. Wakefield,
5 Jr., who was killed in action while in the service of his country with
6 the Marine Corps in Vietnam. A suitable marker bearing such
7 designation shall be attached thereto by the department of public
8 works in compliance with the standards of said department and as
9 authorized by the federal highway administration.
