AN ACT CONCERNING THE STONEHAM BRANCH RAILROAD COMPANY.

Chap. 111

Be it enacted, &c., as follows :

SECTION 1. The Stoneham Branch Railroad Company, incorporated under the two hundred and sixty-eighth chapter of the laws of the year eighteen hundred and fifty-nine, are hereby allowed to construct their railroad across highways and town ways, at such grade and in such manner as the county commissioners may specify and direct.

County commissioners to direct and control crossings.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

AN ACT IN RELATION TO NOTICE TO CREDITORS OF PERSONS ARRESTED ON MESNE PROCESS AND EXECUTION.

Chap. 112

Be it enacted, &c., as follows :

Whenever the notice permitted by the thirteenth section of the one hundred and twenty-fourth chapter of the General Statutes shall be served, by leaving a copy thereof at the last and usual place of abode of the plaintiff or creditor, his agent or attorney, not less than twenty-four hours shall be allowed before the time appointed for the examination.

AN ACT FOR THE APPOINTMENT OF SPECIAL CORONERS.

Chap. 113

Be it enacted, &c., as follows :

SECTION 1. The governor, by and with the consent of the council, shall appoint one or more special coroners for each county in this Commonwealth, who shall have all the powers
