### AN ACT REDUCING THE NUMBER OF PERSONS REQUIRED TO WITNESS A WILL.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Section 1 of Chapter 191 of the General Laws is hereby
- 2 amended by striking out in the third line the word "three"
- 3 and inserting in place thereof the word "two".
