AN ACT RELATIVE TO ROUTE 6A IN THE TOWN OF BREWSTER.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding the provisions of any general or special law to
2 the contrary the board of selectmen of the town of Brewster, after
3 holding a public hearing after consultation with the department of
4 highways, shall have the sole authority with respect to that portion
5 of Route 6A which lies in said town to issue curb cut permits for
6 access to said Route 6A. The provisions of this act shall not apply
7 to projects of the commonwealth.
