RESOLVE IN FAVOR OF JOHN G. MOULTON OF LEOMINSTER.

1 *Resolved*, That, for the purpose of discharging the
2 moral obligation of the commonwealth in the premises
3 and after an appropriation has been made therefor,
4 there be allowed and paid out of the treasury of the
5 commonwealth the sum of _____ dollars
6 to John G. Moulton of Leominster to reimburse him
7 for the expenses of hospital and medical care neces-
8 sarily incurred by him on account of injuries sustained
9 on July twenty-seventh, nineteen hundred and thirty-
10 seven, while he was a private in the one hundred and
11 eighty-first infantry of the Massachusetts national
12 guard at the Massachusetts military reservation.
