AN ACT RELATIVE TO ADDITIONAL TRAINING REQUIREMENTS FOR DAY CARE PROVIDERS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. No renewal of a license of a provider of a day  
2 care center under chapter twenty-eight A of the General Laws for  
3 nineteen hundred and ninety-three and nineteen hundred and  
4 ninety-four shall require any training or certification which was  
5 not required for licensure in nineteen hundred and ninety-two and  
6 the amount of any fee therefor shall not exceed the amount of  
7 said fee in effect in nineteen hundred and ninety-two.

1 SECTION 2. The office for children shall implement  
2 regulations to establish a system to provide credit to providers  
3 of day care centers licensed under chapter twenty-eight A of the  
4 General Laws for previous training or experience in the child care  
5 field in lieu of any additional training requirements. Said office  
6 for children shall review its regulations relative to any additional  
7 training requirements for said providers and shall hold public  
8 hearings at times and places convenient for said providers.
