### DECISION

This was an appeal from the action of the Licensing Board of the City of Boston imposing 4 conditions on the license:

- Functions held on Fridays and Saturdays must conclude by 11:30 p.m. with all patrons off the premises by 11:30 p.m.
- Sunday functions may be held between noon and 6:00 p.m. and there are to be no Sunday night functions.
- At least two members must be present in the function hall for all events and one member must be outside when patrons are disbursing to ensure that patrons neither linger in the neighborhood, nor cause any noise/disturbance in the neighborhood.
- The licensee must keep the board apprised of functions on a monthly basis by submitting a list of said scheduled events.

Based on the testimony, the Alcoholic Beverages Control Commission approves the action of the Local Board in imposing the 4 conditions on the license.
