

Bill accompanying the petition of Andrew A. Casassa for legislation to provide for the acquisition and maintenance as a public park of a certain parcel of land in the town of Revere. Metropolitan Affairs. January 1.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirteen.

AN ACT

To authorize the Metropolitan Park Commission to acquire and improve Certain Land in the Town of Revere.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The metropolitan park commission is
2 hereby authorized and directed to acquire by purchase,
3 gift or right of eminent domain the parcel of land situ-
4 ated near the junction of Revere beach parkway and
5 Campbell avenue, in the town of Revere, the said land
6 having formerly been used as a gravel pit. The metro-
7 politan park commission shall terrace, sod, and other-
8 wise improve the said land, and shall thereafter maintain
9 it as a part of the metropolitan park system. For the
10 purpose of acquiring and improving, as aforesaid, the said
11 land, the commission may expend a sum not exceeding
12 five thousand dollars.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
