RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY BY A SPECIAL COMMISSION RELATIVE TO THE LAWS GOVERNING MOBILE HOME PARKS.

1     *Resolved*, That a special commission to consist of two mem-  
2     bers of the senate, three members of the house of representatives,  
3     the attorney general or his designee, the secretary of the executive  
4     office of communities and development or his designee and four  
5     persons to be appointed by the governor, one of whom shall be  
6     a resident of a mobile home park, one of whom shall be an owner  
7     of a mobile home park and one of whom shall be a representative  
8     of the mobile home federation is hereby established for the  
9     purpose of making an investigation and study of the current laws  
10    pertaining to mobile home parks, their operation, security and  
11    discontinuances. Said commission shall report to the general court  
12    the results of its investigation and study, and its recommendations,  
13    if any, together with drafts of legislation necessary to carry such  
14    recommendations into effect, by filing same with the clerk of the  
15    house of representatives on or before the first Wednesday in  
16    December, nineteen hundred and ninety-two.
