AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY OF ESSEX TO PAY CERTAIN UNPAID
BILLS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law to
2 the contrary, the county commissioners of the county of Essex
3 are hereby authorized to pay from any available monies in
4 the county treasury the following unpaid bills incurred eighteen
5 months or more prior to the passage of chapter five hundred and
6 twenty-nine of the acts of nineteen hundred and sixty-four to
7 Karelitz, Cohen and Brisson, Esq., eleven hundred dollars; and
8 Harry L. Kozol, M.D., nine hundred and seventy-five dollars.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

As enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as
follows:

1. Section 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law to
the contrary, the county court officers of the county of Albany
are hereby authorized to pay from any available monies in
the county treasury the following unpaid bills inured eight
months or more prior to the passage of chapter five hundred and
eighty-nine of the laws of nineteen hundred and twenty-four to
Henry A. Kessel, M.D., nine hundred and seventy-five dollars;
Franklin Cohen and William Egan, seven hundred dollars; and

Section 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
