AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE COMPUTATION OF SERVICE OF A CIVIL SERVICE EMPLOYEE FOR THE PURPOSE OF ESTABLISHING SENIORITY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 15D of chapter 31 of the General Laws is hereby
2 amended by striking out paragraph 1 and inserting in place
3 thereof the following paragraph:—

4 (1) The length of service of a permanent officer or employee
5 shall be computed from the date of his first appointment,
6 whether such appointment was provisional or temporary,
7 other than an appointment on an intermittent or part-time
8 basis, to the official or labor service in the department in which
9 he serves, regardless of class or grade, unless the continuity of
10 his service has been interrupted by an absence from the pay
11 roll of six months or longer, in which case the length of his
12 service shall be computed from the date of his restoration to
13 the pay roll; but upon continuous service following such an
14 absence for a period of twice the length of the absence, the
15 length of his service shall be computed from the date obtained
16 by adding the period of such absence from the pay roll to the
17 date of his original appointment; provided, however, that in
18 the case of a permanent employee, other than one discharged
19 for cause, whose separation from the service was not of his own
20 volition, the length of his service shall be again computed from
21 the date of his first appointment. Proof of absence from the
22 pay roll shall be evidence by official pay roll records.
