The committee on Bills in the Third Reading, to whom was referred the resolve in favor of the Massachusetts Agricultural College (House, No. 131), report recommending the substitution of the following bill.

RESOLVE

In favor of the Massachusetts Agricultural College.

1 *Resolved*, That there be allowed and paid out of the
2 treasury of the Commonwealth to the Massachusetts
3 Agricultural College for the purpose of providing the
4 instruction called for by its charter and by the law of the
5 United States relating to the College, the sum of eight
6 thousand dollars annually for the term of four years,
7 beginning with the first day of January in the year
8 nineteen hundred, the same to be paid in equal quarterly
9 instalments; and further

10 *Resolved*, That there be allowed and paid in the same
11 manner to the said college an additional sum of ten
12 thousand dollars annually, for the term of four years,
13 beginning with the first day of January in the year nine-
14 teen hundred and one, of which five thousand dollars per
15 annum shall be devoted to the purpose already stated,
16 and five thousand dollars per annum shall be used as a
17 labor fund for the assistance of needy students of the
18 college.
