RESOLVE

To provide for Certain Improvements at the State Almshouse.

1 *Resolved*, That there be allowed and paid out of the
2 treasury of the Commonwealth a sum not exceeding
3 sixty-eight thousand five hundred dollars, to be expended
4 at the state almshouse, under the direction of the trustees
5 thereof, for the following purposes, to wit: For the
6 construction of a new ward for insane men, a sum not
7 exceeding fifty thousand dollars, of which amount twenty-
8 five thousand dollars only shall be expended during the
9 present year; for furnishing the new dormitory for men,
10 a sum not exceeding thirty-five hundred dollars; for a
11 new mortuary, and for a new cold storage plant, a sum
12 not exceeding ten thousand dollars; for a building for
13 mechanical work, a sum not exceeding five thousand
14 dollars.
