AN ACT PROVIDING THAT CERTAIN CAMPAIGN EXPENDITURES BE  
ALLOWABLE DEDUCTIONS FOR INCOME TAX PURPOSES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Section 6 of chapter 62 of the General Laws is hereby amended
- 2 by inserting after clause (i) the following clause: —
- 3 (j) The amount of campaign expenditures which a candidate
- 4 for political office, state or municipal, has lawfully made from
- 5 his own personal funds and for his own campaign.
