Chap. 165. AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF BROCKTON TO APPROPRIATE MONEY FOR, AND TO PAY, CERTAIN UNPAID BILLS.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

SECTION 1. The city of Brockton is hereby authorized to appropriate money for the payment of, and after such appropriation the treasurer of said city is hereby authorized to pay, the following unpaid bills: — Brockton Hospital, thirty-nine thousand nine hundred and eighty-four dollars and eighty-two cents; Cardinal Cushing General Hospital, six hundred and forty-seven dollars and eighty-five cents; Goddard Memorial Hospital, one thousand eight hundred and ninety-one dollars and eighty-eight cents; Peter Bent Brigham Hospital, four hundred and seventy-one dollars and forty-three cents; and Goddard Memorial Associates, one hundred and fifty-nine dollars; and certain physicians and druggists, two hundred and eighty-three dollars and eighty cents, in accordance with a list on file with the bureau of accounts; said bills having been incurred in the years nineteen hundred and sixty-six, nineteen hundred and sixty-seven and nineteen hundred and sixty-eight and being legally unenforceable against said city.

SECTION 2. No bill shall be approved by the city auditor of said city for payment or paid by the treasurer thereof under authority of this act unless and until a certificate has been signed and filed with said city auditor, stating under the penalties of perjury that the goods, materials or services for which the bill has been submitted were ordered by an official or an employee of said city, and that such goods and materials were delivered and actually received by said city or that such services were rendered to said city, or both.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
